- 3) Help

To switch languages or keyboards from the taskbar.

- 1) Open regional and language options in control panel
- 2) on the languages tab under text services and input languages click details
- 3) under preferences, click languages bar
- 4) in the languages bar settings dialog box, select the show additional languages bar in the notification area check box
- 5) click ok 3 times
- 6) click the languages icon EN or the keyboard icon keyboard on the taskbar to display a menu.
- 7) click a language or keyboard,

- 10) on start command line look for EN
- 11) click on EN
- 12) switch to Faroese until the FO shows up.
